

# A budget for 2024 Engineering Licensing Fees

In Canada

## 01. Application

Reviewing your transcripts, identity, and good character assessment will cost about \$360 to \$500, depending on your association.

**Budget \$500**



## 02. Technical Exams

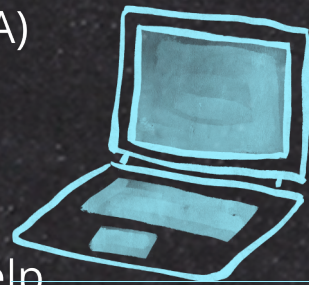


For those without a Canadian degree (or equivalent), 4 technical exams are typical. For each exam, plan for \$250 in books, \$350 in sample solutions and \$400 in sitting fees.

**Budget \$1,000 (per exam)**

## 03. CBA

The competency-based assessment (CBA) requires a deep dive into the best work problems you have solved. There is no association cost for this step. However, using a course and review service will help ensure a strong CBA. **Budget \$500**



## 04. NPPE



The law and ethics exam will cost \$250 (sitting fee) + \$250 (prep course, to make your life easy) + \$275 (textbooks are optional).

**Budget \$500**

## 05. Registration

When you finally earn your P.Eng., there is one final fee—the registration fee, which typically covers the seal, certificate and award Ceremony.

**Budget \$300**
